ORDER

THIS MATTER COMING on to be heard under the Prevailing Wage Act, 820 ILCS 130/0.01-12 and Notice of Hearing issued there under; and, pursuant 56 Illinois Administrative Code 120.301, and 100-670 all parties having been duly advised on the premises issues this order;

FINDINGS:

By agreement of the parties and intervenor, this matter as well as *Jiricek, as a Member of Local 126 of the International Machinists and Aerospace workers, and Local 126 of the International Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers v. Joseph Beyer, Acting Director of Labor and the Illinois Department of Labor, 2018-H-AS09-1992* are consolidated for the sole purpose of presenting arguments on any and all dispositive motions filed.
