2. Any and all Petition(s) to Intervene shall be filed by all interested persons/entities as defined by 56 Ill. Adm. Code 120.320 on or before **August 14, 2017**.
3. All Petitions to Intervene shall comply with 56 Ill. Adm. Code 120.320.
4. Failure to file the Petition in accordance with 56 Ill. Adm. Code 120.320 will result in the Petition not being in compliance with this order and subsequent denial.
5. Any Petition filed **after August 14, 2017** will be deemed untimely and will unduly delay or prejudice the adjudication of rights of the original parties 56 Ill. Adm. Code 120.320 (2).
6. Any and all written responses to timely Petition(s) to Intervene including but not limited to the Petition currently filed by the Laborers' International Union of North America, Southern and Central Illinois Laborers' shall be filed on or before **August 21, 2017**. Any brief accompanying the response shall comply with 56 Ill. Adm. Code 120.301.
7. The Joint Motion to Continue Hearing and Time for Respondent to File Answer is granted. The hearing currently scheduled for August 2, 2017 at 3:00 p.m. is continued. This matter is scheduled for a *telephonic* status conference on **August 28, 2017 at 11:00 a.m.** At this time, status and oral argument on any pending Petitions to Intervene will be heard.
