



The Fringe Benefit Rate combines the fund contributions to be paid on each covered employee (Health & Welfare, PDC 30 MRA, PDC 30 Pension, PDC 30 Apprenticeship, PDC 30 LMIDF, IUPAT LMCI, IUPAT Industry Pension, IUPAT Apprenticeship, and Defense). These rates are totaled for each Contract Type based on employee classification. Note that you are not required to pay PDC 30 Pension Contributions on behalf of Apprentices.
